## INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM

---

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

In order to promote music and to enhance the opportunities on offer to our students, we are able to offer individual tuition during College hours. Depending on student interest, it is envisaged that we will have tutors for the following instruments:

- Voice
- Clarinet\*
- Saxophone\*
- Flute\*
- Guitar-acoustic/electric/ bass
- Piano/ Keyboard
- Drums/Percussion

### ENROLMENT TIMELINE

Students commencing lessons at the beginning of the year must enrol by 18 January 2016. Students commencing lessons during the year must enrol by week 8 of the previous term.

### LESSON TIMETABLE

Lessons take place on a rotating timetable in order that students do not consistently miss any one particular lesson. Upper school students can request a lesson time before school or during recess/lunch.

### PARTICIPATION

All students are required to participate in the Ensemble Program. There are six extra-curricula Ensembles : Junior Guitar Ensemble, Senior Guitar Ensemble, Stage Band, Contemporary Ensemble, Keyboard Ensemble, and Vocal Ensemble.

### PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITY

The college provides performance opportunities for students in the Instrumental and Ensemble Program through concerts, assemblies, and other formal events.

### CONDITIONS OF TUITION

#### FEES:

- Lessons are \$30 per half hour, with an average of 9 lessons a Term.
- Some instruments may have shared lessons (at \$20 per half hour), advised by the tutor.
- Enrolment is yearly, with at least four weeks notice required for withdrawal
- Payment is required before the commencement of lessons each Term and if not received by the due date, students may be refused lessons until payment is made.

#### WITHDRAWAL:

To discontinue lessons, parents must request to withdraw their child by week 8 of the previous Term, otherwise full tuition must be paid.

#### INSTRUMENTS:

Students are required to purchase their own instruments and tutors can provide advice on purchasing instruments. \*Free instrument loan is available to flute, clarinet, and saxophone students in their first year of tuition.

#### ENSEMBLE/BANDS:

It is a compulsory condition for all students enrolled in the Instrumental Program to be a part of an ensemble and regularly attend a tutor nominated ensemble rehearsal, either before or after school.

#### MISSED LESSONS

If a student can't attend his/her lesson due to illness, school excursions, extra-curricular activities, or medical appointments, tutors require at least 48 hours notice via text message in order to reschedule the lesson or offer a 'make-up lesson'. Otherwise, the lesson will be forfeited.
