

## FAMILY CONCESSION

The following discounts apply to Tuition Fees for siblings attending Kennedy concurrently:

- First child Full Tuition fees
- Second child 10% discount off total Tuition Fees
- Third child 20% discount off total Tuition Fees
- Fourth and subsequent children 30% discount off total Tuition Fees

## SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for the holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. Application forms are available from Administration, and some conditions do apply. Closing date for this application is the last day of Term 1: 2 April 2017.

## FINANCIAL DIFFICULTY

The College reserves the right to engage debt collectors, and/or initiate legal action, to recover unpaid fees and charges. All associated debt collection costs incurred by the College will be added to the respective account.

Please note: All fees must be payable in the year in which they are incurred. Outstanding fees at year end may affect the student's enrolment for the following year.

## INSURANCE

## FEES AND CHARGES 2017

The resource fee covers additional resources associated with each year group including (but not limited to) licensing and online subscriptions.

### Other Fees

Yearbook (one per family) and Years 7, 9 & 11 Camps are charged separately.

The Senior school courses listed below also incur additional fees:

- Biology (Year 11) – \$60 for a field trip
- Outdoor Education / Recreation (Year 11 & 12) – \$600 per year for certificates and qualifications
- VET – \$30 per subject certificate fee

## OPTIONAL PROGRAMS

**Music Tuition:** Fees for optional instrumental music tuition are payable direct to the tutor. The engagement of an instrumental tutor by a family is a financial agreement between the family and the tutor. Fees are paid in advance per term to the tutor. The College provides the venue, timetables and ensures all tutors have the required checks and clearances. All instrumental students are required to participate in out of school hours' ensembles.

**Tours – Sporting, Cultural, Academic:** Payment of all tuition and fee accounts must be up-to-date before a student's application for involvement in one of these programs can be considered.

**Basketball / Cricket Specialist:** Fees for these programs are structured as 'fee for service' between an external provider and the College. The College acts as a conduit for the fees and the administrative process of the program. Fees are paid in advance for the year via the College website. The students conduct the program under specialist Kennedy staff in partnership with external expert professional coaches.
