September Search Tips

Words of wisdom from a "search engine"...

Have you ever searched Google, Dogpile, or Bing with no luck? If you know part of the website name or remember a snippet of the headline, does it help?

You would think so. However, a standard "search engine" only locates pages that match the text you specify. You may be left sifting through hundreds, thousands or even millions of results.

Try these easy tips to modify your search and find exactly what you need.

1. (*) wildcard searches

If a query word ends with a (*) all words on a page which start the same way as that query word will match. For example: Try "gift*" for gift ideas, gift baskets or gift wrapping.

2. (+) or (-) qualifiers

If you place a (+) before a search word, the engine will consider that word as a requirement for the results. If you place a (-) in front of the word in a search, the results will exclude that word. For example: "red+phone" will return only sites with word phone and then search for the word red as well.

3. A Boolean search.

You can use the Boolean operators: AND, OR, NOT. Remember, they must be in all capital letters to work. For example: Use "college AND friends" to find sites with both words or try "radioflyer NOT wagon" to eliminate a specific result from your search.

You are now armed with a few new tricks up your sleeve to make your Internet searches more effective.

How To Avoid The Top 5 Budget Busting, Stress-Inducing Mistakes When Moving Your Office

Moving is always a pain in the rump, but it doesn't have to be a horrific, expensive experience. The number one lament from someone who's experienced a "bad" move is, "I didn't know I needed to..." followed closely by "I completely forgot that..." In other words, *it's what you don't do that makes the move a disaster.*

Mistake #1 – Not Using A Checklist

This may seem like a no-brainer to those who manage projects on a regular basis. Even those who use a list typically fail to make the list detailed enough.

Mistake #2 – Trying To Save Money By Using Your Employees To Move Your Computer Network

Don't ask your staff to disconnect, move and reconnect computers, phones and other devices just to save a few bucks. You'll frustrate them and end up with phones ringing at the wrong extension, lost cables, and workstations that get dropped rendering them useless. *Be smart - hire an IT pro to move your network.*

Mistake #3 – Not Hiring The RIGHT IT Firm To Move Your Network

A few things to look for would include references from other clients, proof of insurance (get them to fax you a copy), a service level guarantee limiting the amount of time you are down, and a professional, organized approach to quoting the move.

Mistake #4 – Not Giving Your Phone, Internet And Cable Vendors Enough Advance Warning

Eighty percent (80%) of unexpected communications blackouts and cost overruns on network moves are caused by failure to properly plan voice, data and electrical installation *in advance.*

Mistake #5 – Poor Communication With Clients, Vendors And Employees Prior To, And During The Move

Remember, your computers and phones will be unavailable for a period of time before, during and immediately after the move. A little planning can minimize the impact on your business.
