\$5,000-\$20,000

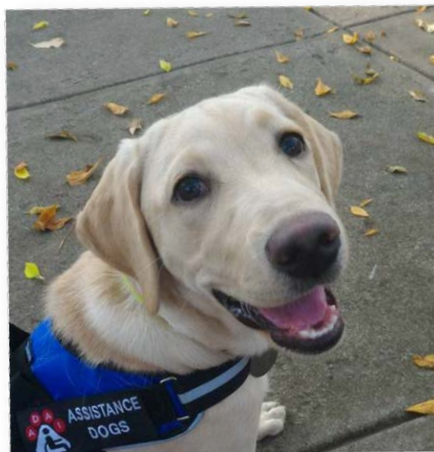
(Minimum \$5,000 for sponsorship; \$20,000 sponsors the entire two-year journey)

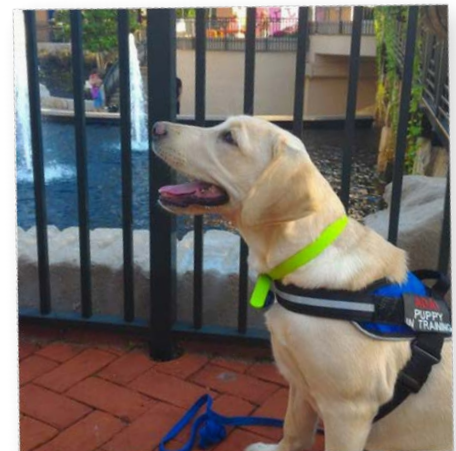
- 🐾 Naming of a puppy
