SHO's Career Development Program

Sho's Career Development Program, (CDP) had a strong re-launch over the past few months. As part of a partnership that was recently established with the Atlanta Center for Self-Sufficiency, (ACSS) six new program participants of the CDP began attending three weeks of morning classes at ACSS. The classes cover subject areas that are critical to a successful transition to self-sufficiency: Topics include but are not limited to: empowerment, reframing, stress management, motivation, and task management.

Each afternoon, program participants perform assigned tasks and attend additional workshops that include subjects such as trusting an employer, how to be the perfect employee, avoiding and resolving income tax issues, addressing credit problems, and dealing with criminal backgrounds. Throughout this period, our staff has assist program participants with applying for employment, some of which are through a partnership that SHO recently established with WorkSource Atlanta. Additionally, SHO's case management staff work with each program participant to address concerns and barriers to securing employment such as housing, health and mental health, transportation and other issues that may arise.
