

Carroll College BYOD Program

Dear Parents and Guardians,

At Carroll College we have a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program. For Year 7-9 the program focuses on iPad's and Years 10-12 are able to bring a device of their own choice.

Students are able to connect their device to the College network and have access to our cloud services – Internet, College emails, Google Drive and Google Classrooms.

Student devices can be:

- A current Windows laptop or tablet
- a current Apple laptop or iPad (See minimum specifications.)
- an 11.6" – 13" Chromebook. A Chromebook is a laptop that runs Google Apps for Education, but does not run Windows or Mac OSX Programs. Android or Linux devices are not supported.

Student devices can be purchased from any supplier as long as they meet the minimum specifications. The college has been in discussions with Clyde Computers Batemans Bay, who have put together a number of options for Carroll College students. Please see details below and attached flyer.

Every reasonable attempt will be made to connect the device to the school wireless network. However, there is no guarantee as the school is limited to connecting devices supported by Catholic Education.

Some Details for the Carroll College BYOD Program:

- We recommend a light compact laptop, tablet or convertible device.
- Mobile phones will NOT be connected to the College BYOD Wireless Network.
- Only ONE personal device will be allowed to be connected.
- Students and parents will need to sign a BYOD ICT Agreement needs to be signed by parents/carers and students before access is given.
- Use of the BYOD is subject to teacher direction and misuse of the device may lead to consequences as set out in the signed agreement.
- Devices are to be used for school work only and students are to only use approved applications.
- Access to the Internet will be filtered.
- Student devices will not be able to access the College network drives, H Drive or S Drive or College printers.
- The College will not provide any technical support for devices.
- Devices need to be fully charged as they are unable to be charged at school due to WH&S issues.
- Students are responsible for maintaining their personal device, charging, upgrading software etc.
- As outlined in the BYOD User Agreement, the College **will not** be responsible for damage or theft of personal devices.
