

UNIFORM

PERSONAL PRESENTATION

The appearance and behaviour of our students on their way to and from school ought at all times 'speak' of their pride in their College. All students are expected to follow the College policy on uniform. Students are asked to be neat and tidy and to wear their uniform with pride. It is also expected that our students will be friendly, courteous and respectful to members of the public. If a student's general appearance and conduct does not fulfil College expectations, offending students will lose the privilege of representing the College on excursions, sport, public speaking, debating, and other such events.

HAIR POLICY

The College policy is that hair is to be clean, neat, safe and tidy at all times.

- The College policy is that hair is to be clean, neat, safe and tidy at all times.
- Hair is to be off the face i.e. fastened back with slides or ties,
- Collar length hair and longer hair is to be tied back at all times,
- Scrunchies, ribbons and ties are to co-ordinate with the uniform being worn,
- A "number 2" cut is the shortest limit for an all-over haircut or for an undercut that extends above the ears,
- On the sides, undercut "overhang" should not extend below the tops of the ears,
- A step-style is acceptable with the shortest part not less than a "number 2" cut,
- Coloured hair must remain within the limits of the natural hair range (this includes not overtly multi-coloured). Dreadlocks are not considered acceptable nor appropriate and are therefore not permitted at the College,
- Students are to be clean-shaven unless religious or medical reasons necessitate otherwise,
- Mullets, Mohawks and patterned shaving are not permitted as hairstyles,
- Principal's discretion applies in all cases.

HEADWEAR

Students are to wear the College cap while participating in any outdoor sporting activity. The College cap is also to be worn at recess and lunchtime during Terms 1 and 4, if choosing to be in the sun. It is recommended that protective sunscreen be also worn at these times. College caps are available to purchase from the Canteen.

JEWELLERY

College uniform permits the following jewellery: wristwatch, signet ring, chain with religious medal or cross, and earrings (sleepers or studs with no more than one in either or both ears in the lower part of the lobe only). Facial piercing jewellery is not permitted. A clear, unobtrusive plastic stud will be permitted to preserve a facial piercing. Multiple piercings are not permitted.

Safety requires that earrings are to be covered in PE periods and sport.

Make-up or nail polish (except clear) is not acceptable with College uniform.

SHOES

- During practical subjects (PDHPE, Sport) students must wear predominantly white or black athletic shoes. This is due to Occupational Health and Safety reasons.
- Rabens, Dunlop Volley's, Skate style shoes and any slip on forms of shoes are not permitted at any time.

WHEN OUT OF UNIFORM

For any variation to uniform, students are asked to provide a note giving:

- Name,
- Date,
- Reason for incorrect uniform,
- The length of expected time out of correct uniform,
- Signature of parent / guardian.

Students present this note to the homeroom teacher who will sign, date, comment if necessary, before returning note to student for safe-keeping. Every effort must be made to return to correct College uniform as quickly as possible.

OUT OF UNIFORM DAYS

Occasionally, students will have the opportunity to wear casual clothing. The requirement on these days is that students dress suitably for the school setting i.e. modest dress and closed-in shoes are a requirement.

UNIFORM CHANGE-OVER DATES

The Summer Uniform is to be worn Term 1 and Term 4, unless otherwise directed by the Principal or Assistant Principal.

The Winter Uniform is to be worn Term 2 and Term 3, unless otherwise directed by the Principal or Assistant Principal.

SECOND HAND UNIFORMS

Second hand uniforms are available for purchase by contacting Nadine Cooper (or Front office) to check availability. Donations are gratefully received.

PURCHASING UNIFORMS

The sports uniform and jacket can only be purchased through the College. You can purchase uniform locally in Batemans Bay through Hip Pocket Workwear, Stitches or Lowes.

JUNIOR GIRLS' UNIFORM (Years 7 – 10)

Summer

Teal and white checked dress (Peter Pan collar) – length should be on the knee
White ankle-length socks (worn approximately 4 cm above the ankle),
Black leather lace-up school shoes (not jogger, boots, mary-jane or ballet style), heel not to exceed 4 cm,
Teal V-neck woollen jumper, maroon stripe and embroidered crest,
Black caps with College crest.

Winter

White school shirt, long or short sleeves with teal collar and embroidered crest,
Tartan skirt, two box pleats front and back (skirt must be on or just below knee length),
Teal V-neck woollen jumper, maroon stripe and embroidered crest,
Black opaque or ribbed tights,
Black leather lace-up school shoes (not jogger, boots, mary-jane or ballet style), heel not to exceed 4cm.
Optional—White ankle socks may be worn with winter skirt on warm days.

JUNIOR BOYS' UNIFORM (Years 7 – 10)

Summer

Dark grey college shorts (Yakka or Uni Gate),
Dark grey mélange trousers (Yakka 12879 or 12379 or Standex 777),
White shirt, short sleeved, open teal neck with embroidered crest,
Teal V-neck woollen jumper, maroon stripe and embroidered crest,
Dark grey socks with shorts or trousers,
Black leather lace-up school shoes (not jogger style or boots), heel not to exceed 4cm,
Black belt (plain),
Black cap with College crest.

Winter

Dark grey mélange trousers (Yakka 12879 or 12379 or Standex 777),
White school shirt, long or short sleeved, open teal neck with embroidered crest,
Dark grey socks,
Teal V-neck woollen jumper, maroon stripe and embroidered crest,
Black leather lace-up school shoes (not jogger style or boots), heel not to exceed 4cm,
Black belt (plain).

SPORTS AND PE UNIFORM – GIRLS AND BOYS (Years 7 – 12)

SPORTS AND PE (7-12) GIRLS AND BOYS

The PE uniform is to be worn to school on the designated sport day which each year group has once per week. The sports uniform is not to be worn on other days unless requested by the College.

Note: *The sports uniform is only available for purchase through the College Uniform shop.

- Black micro-fibre tracksuit pants, with white stripe and zipper at bottom, (not leggings or tights)*
- Black micro-fibre shorts with white stripe,*
- Teal collared sports polo,*
- White socks or white sports socks (no logos or stripes),
- Joggers that must be predominantly white or predominantly black, (not volleys, skate shoes, rabens or slip-ons)
- Regulation cricket cap with teal crest (available from canteen).

For Work Health and Safety reasons during practical subjects (PDHPE, Sport) students must wear predominantly white or black athletic shoes. Rabens, Dunlop Volley's, Skate style shoes and any slip on forms of shoes are not permitted at any time.

SENIOR GIRLS' UNIFORM (Years 11 – 12)

Teal straight or pleated skirt with kick pleat - knee length,
White school shirt, long or short sleeve, open neck with teal collar and embroidered crest
Black stockings (opaque, not sheer),
Black leather lace-up school shoes (not jogger, boots, Mary-Jane or ballet style), heel not to exceed 4cm,
Teal V-neck woollen jumper, maroon stripe and embroidered crest.
Optional - White ankle socks (approximately 4cm above the ankle) can be worn on warmer days).

SENIOR BOYS' UNIFORM (Years 11 – 12)

Taupe trousers (Yakka Comfort 02579 colour 287) or taupe shorts in summer,
White school shirt, long sleeved, hard teal collar,
School Tie,
Teal V-neck woollen jumper, maroon stripe and embroidered crest,
Fawn socks,
Black leather lace-up school shoes (not jogger style or boots), heel not to exceed 4cm.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS TO UNIFORMS FOR ALL STUDENTS

Black scarf (with College crest) *can only be purchased through the College.
Black beanie (with College crest) *can only be purchased through the College.
College blazer (black with College crest).
College jacket (black with College crest) *can only be purchased through the College.
