

# *Fellowship Guidelines*

## **Eligibility and Selection:**

1. Applicants with one of the following qualifications are eligible for appointment:
  - a. M.D. or D.O. Degree
  - b. Completion of Family Practice Residency
  - c. Possess/obtain a Full and Unrestricted California Medical License
  - d. Valid DEA License
  - e. Demonstrated interest/achievement in Primary Care Sports Medicine
  - f.
    1. Graduate of medical school in the U.S. and Canada accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME).
    2. Graduate of college of osteopathic medicine in the U.S. accredited by the AOA.
    3. Graduate of medical school outside the U.S. and Canada who meet one of the following qualifications:
      - Have received a currently valid certificate from the Education Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates or
      - Have a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in a U.S. licensing jurisdiction.
  - g. Graduates of medical schools outside the US who have completed a Fifth Pathway program provided by an LCME-accredited medical school.
2. Selection is ensured from among eligible applications on the basis of their preparedness, ability, aptitude, academic credentials, communication skills, and personal qualities such as motivation and integrity.
3. There is no discrimination with regard to sex, race, age, religion, color, national origin, disability or veteran status.
4. Have completed 3-year residency program.
5. **Have completed a rotation and/or interview rotation with our facility.**
