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CCAP is quickly growing youth cycling thanks to partnerships with local race promoters. Your partnership helps bring more kids into the sport of cycling and creates more life-long riders.

To qualify as part of the CCAP Junior Race Series, an event must offer a stand-alone junior race which is NOT combined with any other fields.

Events should offer a reduced or waived entry fees for juniors registered with a CCAP program.

Events must hold a USAC permit.

Only CCAP registered school teams, regional teams and/or Park & Rec teams qualify for series points. The CCAP accepts registration from Connecticut teams only.

Regional and Park & Rec team coaches are required to hold a USAC Coaching license.

CCAP will work with promoters to keep events consistent in categories, time and length of races in the series races and will provide medals for those races requesting them.

CCAP will use our marketing venues to help promote races that are part of our CCAP Series and bring junior riders to these races.

CCAP will have direct links on our site to registration pages for those events who are part of our series.
